- Mapping for major courses might be different than for general education courses, and it would only affect a handful
  of students.
- Some departments (like Math) are already in this process because of either Dean request or the PUR process.
- We should trust departments to do their job and this is not the purview of CRC. These items should be fixed during the PUR process.
- It might help people when creating courses if this is more than a check box and includes a short narrative about how a course fits into the program.
- · Does it make it easier for the PUR?
